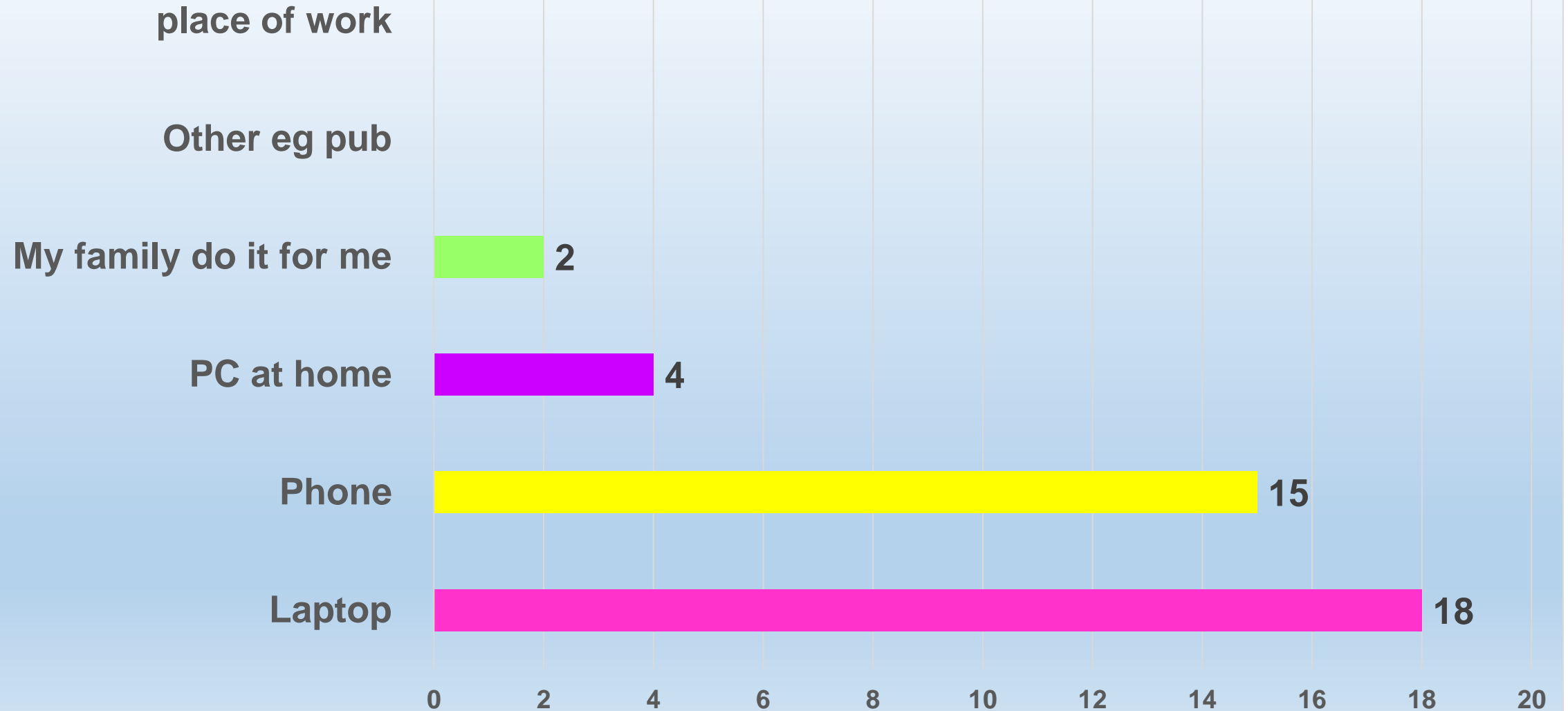

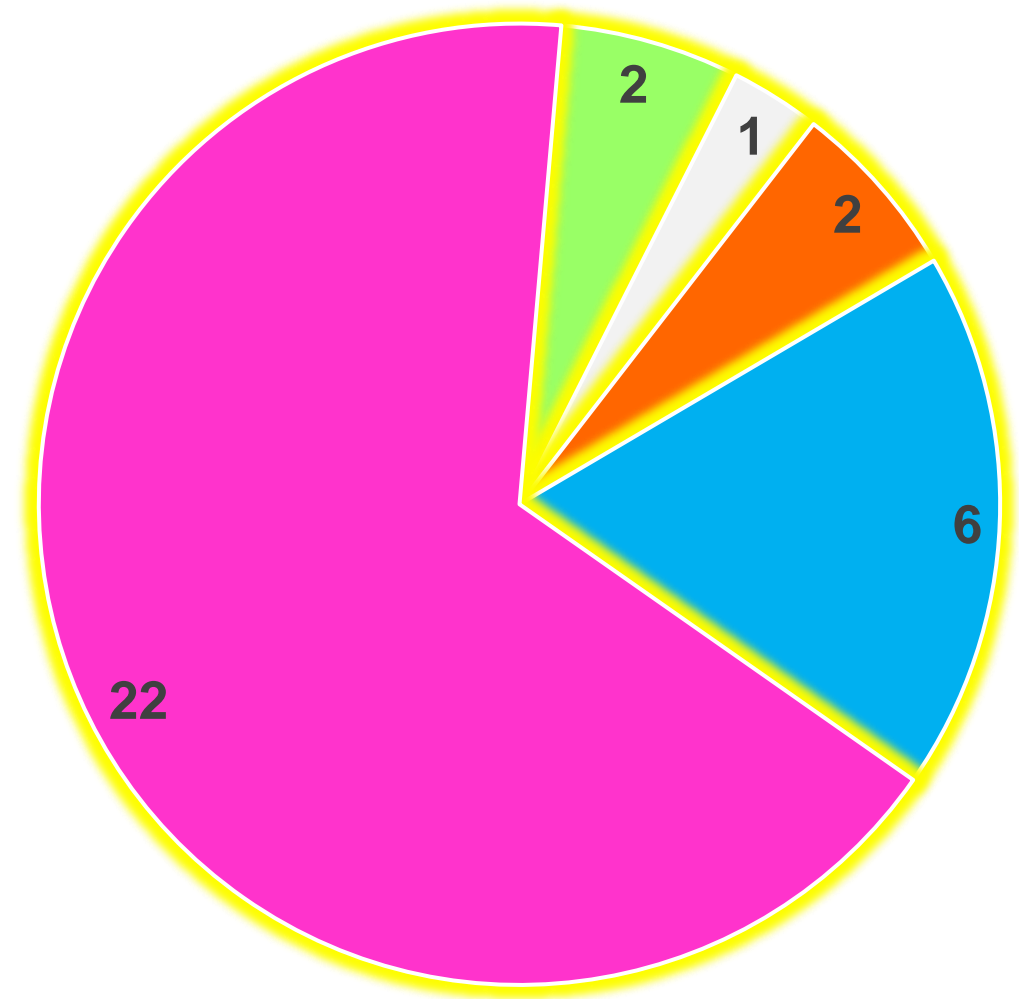

Exploring the knowledge of the CEC Livewell Directory and its use - asked to comment upon "I am aware of the directory and know how to use it"

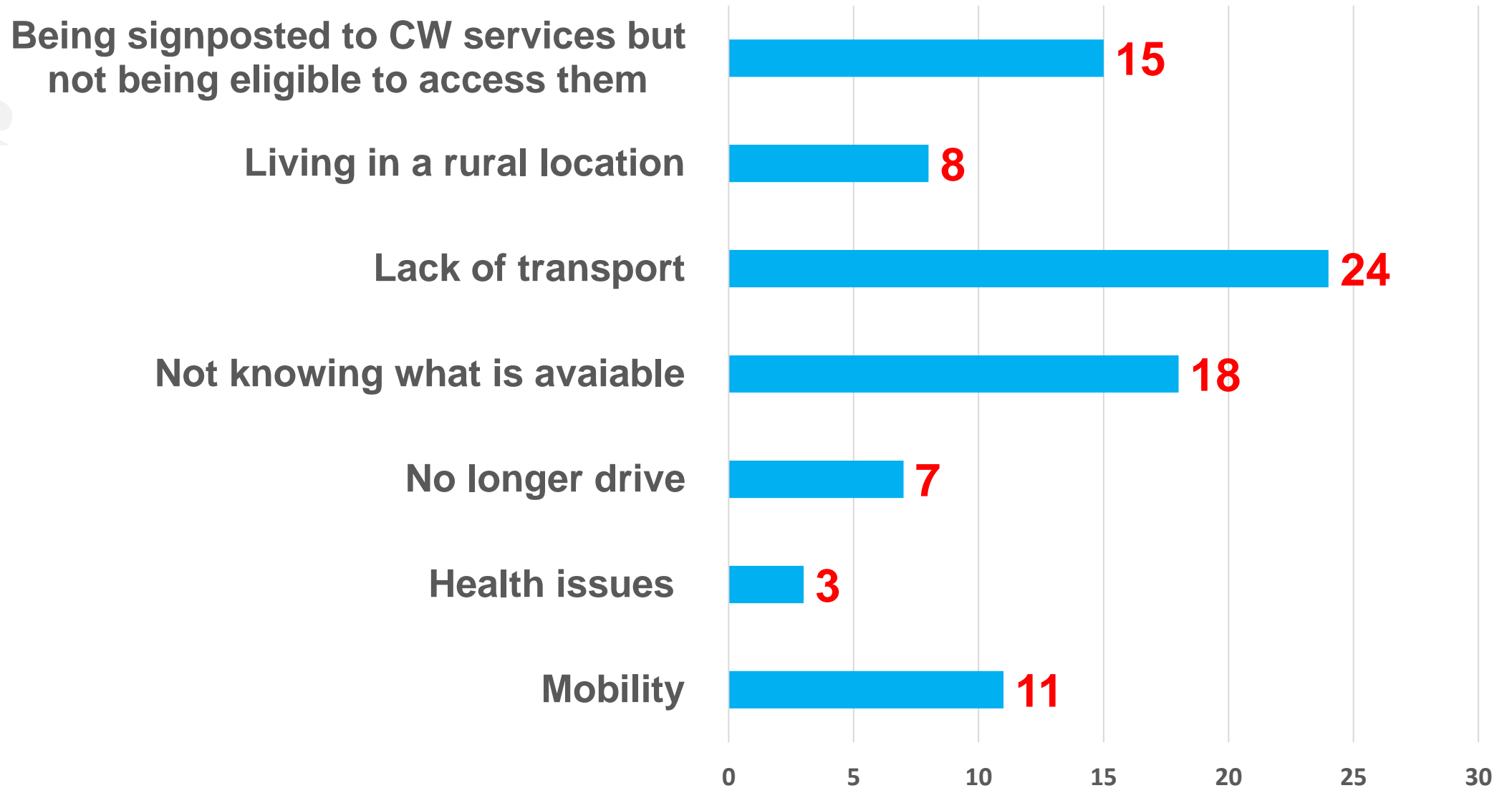
- Agree

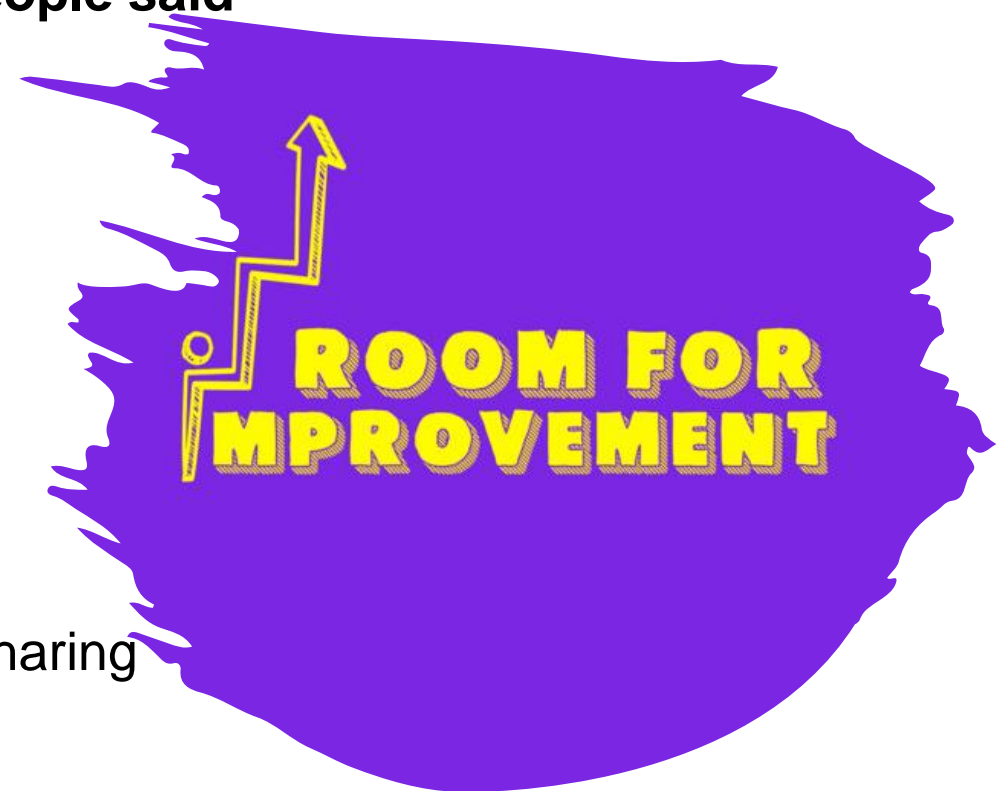
